FACTS

The average person in the UK will spend approximately 88,000 hours at work.

Work will occupy about 40% of our life.

The average 'committed' Christian will spend 4000 to 6000 hours at church being involved in church related activities!

There are some 350,000 believing Christians at Work.

Approximately 107 workplace Christian Fellowship groups are affiliated to *Christians at Work*. These groups represent almost every sector of employment, banking to aerospace, ship building to health services, retail and education.

Groups remain autonomous, but *Christians at Work* seeks to support and unite them in fellowship, providing resources, visits by the National Director and seeking to provide a sense of partnership in the work of the gospel.

- ✿ *Christians are called to live out their faith, giving glory to God in every aspect of their lives – That includes work.*
- ✿ *The workplace provides Christians with a tremendous opportunity to share the good news of the Lord Jesus Christ through their lives, words and attitudes.*

The quarterly newsletter, *Networking* is distributed to approximately 300 individuals.
